Easy Read – People under Guardianship and Administration. Your Right to share your story.

- This is about a law in Victoria.
- The law says people with disability who have a Guardian or Administrator are not allowed to tell the media their story.
- A Guardian or Administrator is a person or organisation that makes decisions for you.
- This means if you want to tell your story about what it is like to have a Guardian or Administrator, you must ask if it is ok first.
- Life Without Barriers provides support for people with disability.
- We do not agree that you should be stopped from telling your story to the media if you want to.
- It is better for everyone if you can share your story if you choose to, because it means everyone will work harder to help you in the right way.
- We believe everyone has the right to make decisions.
- We also agree that everyone has the right to take risks.
- Everyone has the right to support.
- Everyone should respect what a person decides.
- Life Without Barriers also believes that people who work in media must do the right thing for people with disability.
- This means people working in media should respect you, your choices and decisions.
