
































In addition to the Australian Government Department of Health 'in reach' vaccination options for people with disability in residential care (Phase 1a), and access through General Practitioners and large Hospital Hubs, there are now state-based options for vaccination becoming available. Vaccination is voluntary, however, Life Without Barriers' Vaccination Status Policy requires staff to advise of their vaccination status. Vaccination Eligibility (as relevant to Life Without Barriers)

- **Group 1a** – Disability residential care (SIL) frontline staff; disability care (SIL) residents where there are 2 or more in a house
- **Group 1b** – Adults 70 yrs+; Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples 55 yrs+; younger adults with underlying medical condition incl. a disability; disability and aged care frontline workers; and disability clients attending centre-based services, NDIS funded participants 16 yrs+
- **Group 2a** – Adults 40 yrs+; Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples aged 18-54 yrs; other critical and high risk workers
- **Group 2b** – Balance of adult population; catch up of any unvaccinated Australians from previous phases
- **Phase 3** – 18 yrs and under if recommended
