<p>There are 3 different purposes – ‘purpose’ means the reason the funds are being provided to you.</p> <p>1. Core – Core funds assist with areas of your daily life.</p> <p>2. Capital – Capital funds assist you to purchase technological aids and add ramps or rails etc. to your house so you can live in it easier.</p> <p>3. Capacity Building – assist you to learn to take care of your business matters, connect with the community around you, and learn skills.</p>	<p>The Outcome Domain has been broken into 10 areas.</p> <p>These are the areas of your life that will be improved as a result of you receiving NDIS funding.</p>	<p>Support Category is broken into 15 support categories. This how the NDIS has grouped all the different supports an NDIS Plan can fund – there are hundreds of different supports available (called support items) and they are all grouped under these 15 categories.</p>	<p>Support Items are the specific supports that the funding will cover.</p> <p>They have a long Item Number as a reference and Disability Providers use the information to quote for service and claim funds from your plan as they give you the support you asked for.</p>
